

What is the Leeds Care Record?



At the moment every health and social care organisation has a different set of records about you.



Your new Leeds Care
Record will share
appropriate information
from different records
to health and social
care professionals
directly involved in
your care

What kind of information will be shared?



List of diagnosed conditions

so health or social care professionals have a complete record of your care.



Medications

everyone treating you knows what medicines you need.



Allergies

to make sure you are not given medicines that you will react badly to.



Test results

to speed up your treatment and care.



Referrals, letters and discharge information

to make sure the people caring for you have all the information they need about other treatment you're having.




Address and telephone number your up to date contact details.

Why do you need to share my information?



You will get better support once your information is in one place.



You won't have to repeat information to different professionals.



Care professionals won't need to spend time phoning around different organisations.


What are the benefits of a Leeds Care Record?



 Joined up and safer care.



 More time to spend on your care.



Less paperwork.

Can anybody see my records?



No. Only care professionals directly involved in your care will see your Leeds Care Record.



We won't share your information with anyone, it will be kept private.

How do I know my record is secure?



By law your records must be kept private by care professionals.



The Leeds Care Record is kept on a secure computer system.



Data protection laws are clear. We regularly check that the records are looked at by care professionals.

Can I access my care records?



Yes. Under the Data
Protection Act 1998
you can ask to see
any of the information
that an organisation or
care provider holds
about you.

Can I opt out of my records being shared?



Yes. You can choose not to have a Leeds Care Record.
