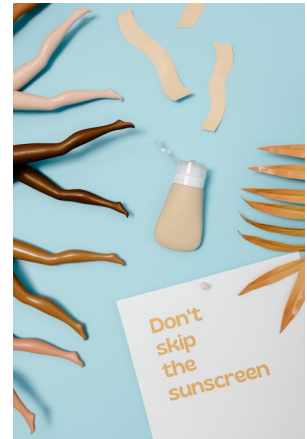
These are major investments for the surgery and only possible due to your generosity and support. These items will enhance the health, safety and care provided to patients.

SUMMER HOLIDAYS

With the rise in skin cancers, it is very important to protect skin from the sun's rays and UV radiation – when the UV index reaches 3 or above protection is needed – cover bare skin, use a suncream 30+, wear a wide brimmed hat, wear good sunglasses, find some shade.
